Principal's Report:

- Bump it up program continuing
- Child and Family Practitioner, Lisa Navin, to start Friday 16.03.18 providing support to families with referrals to outside agencies, housing, domestic violence, NDIS, etc. This Family Referral Service is completely funded as part of Project Dadirri.
- BPS invited to take part in a new program "Top Blokes", addressing social issues impacting boys ages 11-13 (Stepping Up) teaching them social and emotional resilience in a peer-led mentoring environment. Ten year 6 boys have been selected to participate in the launch at no cost to the school.
- Many activities throughout the year, including; Life Education, Sports in Schools, Drumbeats, Pet Program, etc.
- Canteen upgrade submission has been approved and will be paid for by the school. It cannot be done in the school holidays so Sophie is continuing to brain storm a contingency plan for when a date is set for work to be carried out.
- Uniforms for the school's soccer teams have been priced at \$1 800 for 30 whole sets of uniforms. Proposed that P&C fund this purchase. All voted, none opposed.
- Coles 'Schools for Sports' vouchers to date exceed 40,000++. Wishlist started with emphasis on play equipment.
- Assistant Principals position is being readvertised 14.03.2018 and to be finalised at the end of term.
- Classroom teacher position to become available with the resignation of Mrs Kirchner.
- Term costs to go out this week 12.03.2018
- Stage 3 Cyber Bulling workshop coming up and BPS is signed up to take part in the National Day of Action against Bullying
