Professional Learning

This week our staff are engaging in evidence based, high quality professional learning to ensure they are implementing the best teaching strategies for our students. Professional Learning this week has included a seminar with other local schools conducted by education consultant John Fleming. Mr Fleming is an experienced educator who specialises in a style of teaching called Explicit Instruction. This model of teaching has proven to be highly effective at transferring surface level learning to a deeper level ensuring students can not only retain what has been learnt but also apply this knowledge in a range of different contexts.

Tonight our teachers will also be engaging with the work of John Hattie who has conducted wide scale research into the most effective teaching strategies around the world. This research has culminated in the creation of 'Visible Learning'. Visible Learning promotes students been aware of their own learning and discovering how to reach their full potential.

Finally, the schools' leadership team will be working with Simon Popley through his Coaching Leadership Institute to develop our leadership skills. As our school is undertaking transformational change, it is Important that our leadership team is constantly developing the skills to lead this change so our school can be the very best it can be. I know that our leadership team, along with all our staff are excited about these professional learning opportunities.

Attendance

Our school has high expectations when it comes to attendance. Our goal this year is to have a school wide attendance rate of 96%. So far we are sitting at 95%. Every day of attendance matters. Every day lost due to absences can have a profound effect on students reaching their potential. Please ensure that unless your child is sick or there is a significant family commitment, they are attending school every single day.




Wellbeing
