

Budgewoi Swimming Carnival 2020

The 2020 Budgewoi Public School Swimming Carnival will be held on **Friday 21st February**, at Swansea Swimming Pool, Swansea. (Week 4 – Term 1). This is a compulsory school day, absence will require a note from parents/caregivers. Please read the refund policy on the back of this note.

Students will be departing the school by bus at 9:00am and arrive at Swansea at 9:30am for the start of the carnival. They will depart the venue at 2:00pm for arrival back at school prior to the home time bell.

The Carnival is for students 8yrs – 13yrs. Students must wear appropriate swimming attire and may wear appropriate sun safe house colours on the day. Students should bring sunscreen and wear a wide brimmed or bucket hat.

Competitors who place 1st or 2nd or 3rd overall in their 50m Freestyle age event or competitors who place 1st or 2nd overall in the 100m Freestyle, 50m Breaststroke, 50m Butterfly or 50m Backstroke for their age group have an opportunity to represent the school at the Zone Carnival later in Term 1. (Note that 8, 9 and 10yrs are under the one age for all events except the 50m Freestyle.) Junior and Senior Relay teams will be chosen from the fastest four boys and girls 50m Freestyle times from the carnival.

Strong swimmers wishing to compete in the 100m Freestyle event will need to be transported to the Carnival prior to 8:45am. Due to time restraints, the 100m event will start at 9:00am sharp. If you are unable to transport your child or if you can assist by supplying transport for the 100m event, please indicate on the note below.

The cost of transport and admission is \$11.00. (Students travelling to the venue by private vehicle for the 100m event only need to pay \$4.00 for admission to the Pool.) A cost of \$3.00 entry is for all spectators attending.

Canteen Facilities will be available on the day. However a packed recess, lunch and water bottle are recommended.

Important Note:

When a medical practitioner has prescribed medication (including emergency medication) that will need to be administered during the excursion, parents are responsible for:

* Bringing this need to the attention of the school

* Ensuring that the information is updated if it changes

* Supplying the medication and any 'consumables' necessary for its administration in a timely way. The medication should be well within its expiry date

* Collaborating with the school in working out arrangements for the supply and administration of the prescribed medication for the duration of the excursion. For some excursions the school will ask you to supply the medication in a different way to what has already been agreed to by the school. You may be asked to supply an additional adrenaline autoinjector (ie EpiPen/Anapen) for example.
