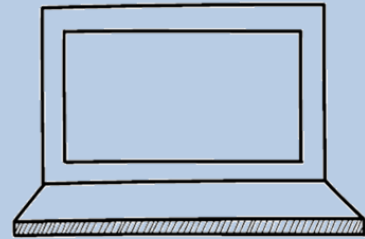




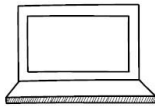

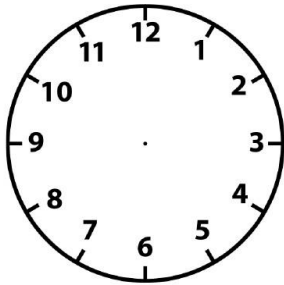
At Budgewoi Public School, we are encouraging students and teachers to use **Zoom** as a platform to stay connected with each other each day.

ZOOM Etiquette

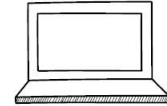


1. Be on time.

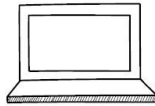
2. Be present.

- Use nice words when you speak and when you write.

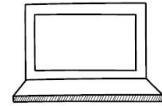


- Dress appropriately.

4. Use video. Stay muted.

- Keep your video on. 
- Use your eyes to track the person who is speaking. 
- Mute your microphone. 
- Click the "raise hand" button and wait for your turn to speak.
