Budgewoi Swimming Carnival 2023

(Please return the permission note and money to your class teacher by February 15th February. There will be NO late notes and payments accepted due to bus booking organisation.) This is a compulsory school day, absence will require a note from parents/caregivers.

- What:** Budgewoi Swimming Carnival
- Who:** Students between the ages of 8-13 years
- Where:** Swansea Swimming Pool
- When:** Wednesday 22nd February, 2023. Week 5, Term 1
- Transport:** Private Car or Bus
- Time:** Bus departing school by **9am** and departing the venue by **2pm**, arriving back at school before the home time bell. **Strong swimmers** wishing to compete in the 100m Freestyle event will need private transportation to the Carnival and arrive before **8:45am**, ready for a 9am start.
- Bring:** Appropriate swimming attire, sunscreen, wide brimmed hat or a bucket hat. Canteen facilities will be open on the day, but bringing bottled water and a packed lunch is recommended.

Competitors who place 1st or 2nd or 3rd overall in their 50m Freestyle age event or competitors who place 1st or 2nd overall in the 100m Freestyle, 50m Breaststroke, 50m Butterfly or 50m Backstroke for their age group have an opportunity to represent the school at the Zone Carnival later in Term 1. (Note that 8, 9 and 10yrs are under the one age for all events except the 50m Freestyle.) Junior and Senior Relay teams will be chosen from the fastest four boys and girls 50m Freestyle times from the carnival.

The cost of transport and admission is \$11.00. (Students travelling to the venue by private vehicle for the 100m event only need to pay \$4.00 for admission to the Pool.)

Important Note:

When a medical practitioner has prescribed medication (including emergency medication) that will need to be administered during the excursion, parents are responsible for:

- * Bringing this need to the attention of the school
- * Ensuring that the information is updated if it changes
- * Supplying the medication and any 'consumables' necessary for its administration in a timely way. The medication should be well within its expiry date
- * Collaborating with the school in working out arrangements for the supply and administration of the prescribed medication for the duration of the excursion. For some excursions the school will ask you to supply the medication in a different way to what has already been agreed to by the school. You may be asked to supply an additional adrenaline autoinjector (ie EpiPen/Anapen) for example.
